### **2.) Data Collection**

(Desk research, Monitoring of project activities, questionnaires, interviews from project partners and other stakeholders)

### **3.) Data Analysing**

(qualitative and quantitative research)

### **4.) Reporting**

(ongoing feedback, mid-term and Final Report)
